2. Article IV - to insert a new Section 10 to set forth the duties and responsibilities of the Controller and for the original Section 10 to be renumbered as Section 11; and
3. Article VI, Section 2 - to reflect that the books of accounts of the Corporation shall be prepared under the direction of the Controller instead of the Treasurer.

Article IV, Section 1	SECTION 1. ELECTION, TERM OF OFFICE AND QUALIFICATIONS. At the organizational meeting referred to in Article III, Section 3 of these By-Laws, the Board of Directors shall elect a Chairman of the Board, a Vice-Chairman, a President and Chief Executive Officer, one or more Executive Vice-Presidents, one or more Senior Vice Presidents, one or more Vice Presidents, a Treasurer and a Secretary and may also from time to time appoint such other officers and agents as it may deem proper.
